Tiffany Park Pathway Clean up May 3rd

Members of the Tiffany Park Neighborhood spent a busy day in May cleaning up a pathway that was overgrown and "a little scary." The pathway cuts through from Index Ave to Lake Youngs Way, leading to Tiffany Park Elementary School. The pathway had been untended for about 15 years and sorely needed attention. With the permission of the adjoining property owners (who helped in the effort), a volunteer crew of about two dozen volunteers (age 8 years old to 75!) pulled weeds, cut back hedges, removed ivy and picked up garbage. An arborist was hired to cut back eight evergreen trees that were overhanging the path.
