6:33 Treasurer report (Cynthia)

7:20 Tree preservation- (Cynthia)

- Renton has tree preservation and in order to take down any trees on private property or other, if the tree is basically a foot in diameter, must get approval from City and pay for a permit. If someone goes ahead and takes down one of these trees without prior approval then the fines can be quite high, 10K etc.
- Trees provide oxygen, shade, flooding, wind, and sound protection. When a big tree is removed, there are impacts to the surrounding neighbors.
- There are 2 qualified arborists at the City of Renton and they are working on education for neighborhoods and even other City of Renton staff.
- Bill raised issues about having no choice to deal with other people's trees on his property such as tree roots, leaves, etc.
