7:33 Welcome- Quorum call (Lynda)

7:34 Approve minutes from 8.6.24 (Lynda) Anna moved to approve the minutes (taken by Cynthia last month), Dave seconded.

7:35 Treasurer report (Cynthia)

- Still waiting to receive money from the city from movie night.
- Has the Grant amount received match the expenditures? ANSWER: It will once we get all the funds returned to us from the city.
- The yearly fee for Weebly website due this September. Auto renewal. Was this renewed? ANSWER: Yes, it was paid. September 2024.
- We will raise the credit card limit to allow some of the higher bills.

7:45 Movie Night- 8.16.24 (Lynda)

- Some miscommunications with the city. The event was not on the calendar. We will try to make sure this is on the City's calendars next year. Focusing more on communication would be good for next year.
- Movie: Reimbursed from grant.
- Posters: The city provided 2 posters. We had a total of 5 posters.
- There were substantial, significant amounts of personal money paid for movie night up front. This was a hardship, and we would prefer not to do this again. Discuss Sponsorship next year.
- Email Signup: We had an email sign up for people who were interested in just information. We will send everyone on the list an email asking them to join

TPNA.

Cynthia will be drafting an email soon and will send out to the group.

- We had a poster with just the 2 QR codes. One for our Facebook page and one for our membership page.
- Food : 13 boxes * 28/box = 364 3-4 boxes left over.
- Gelato: We had ordered 200 servings. There were 152 pink tickets given out. (2 of which were raffle tickets.) Since there were left over servings, we let people go for seconds until the servings were used. They used the cups to count 200 servings. We just had them used the flavors that were there if they ran out of any flavor. They did have back up flavors and a person back at their kitchen, if any additional product needed to be brought.
- Water : We have 100's of compostable cups left over. We had ordered 500 – 4 oz. Cynthia got two 2-gallon waters with spout. It seemed we only used one of them.
- Equipment: Megaphone borrowed from Lynda.
- Items we have left over for next year: raffle tickets, pink tickets for gelato, & name tags.
- For clean up, we brought our own 30-gallon trash bags, dish gloves and flashlights.
- We brought a donation jar: We received \$9 in donations.
- Bring yellow TPNA vests, duct tape, scissors.
- The Neighborhood Program brought, games, chairs, tables, and A-frame Sidewalk poster Stand.
- Door prizes: Marina: 3x\$25. Anything over \$75, she and her friend, Deb, donated to TPNA.
- Tickets were given to those age 12 or above. We took a picture of the first ticket to find out how many tickets were given out. 159 raffle tickets were given out.
- Games: The Neighborhood Program provided: Connect Four, Jenga, & parachute.
We put the Jenga on the walkway by the Futsol court. It was out of the way and a flat surface. The children moved the parachute from the game area, down to the front of the viewing area and ended up wrapping themselves up for the movie.
- Face painter: 1 face painter: \$102.50 x 2 hours = \$205.00, no tax on invoice.

- Helpers: Were Lynda, Cynthia, Bob, Marina, Debbie, Dave, Reid and Clair from the

Neighborhood program.

8:10 GCP clean up: (Lynda)

- Clean up Kiosk: October.
- Lynda will work on getting a QR code for the bulletin board at the park along with an updated membership form.
- Trash pick-up from Parks and Rec has continued.
- Colleen has still been mowing. We would like to give her a bigger gift card at some point in the future.
